Livestream Performance

The livestream performance is hosted **live-in-real-time** by our Actor/Educator and includes interactive segments for students to answer quizzes, have guided discussions and ask questions in real time!

The performance is captured live-on-film with multi-cameras and in high definition, meaning everyone will be watching from the best seat in the house. Hosting a *Perform Education Livestream Incursion* means your whole school can be involved whether having a large group viewing, classroom by classroom sessions, or even with individual students included from home.

Interactive Q&A

The session includes an interactive Q&A with the live host for your students to explore some of the themes and key questions connected to the learning points.

Program Overview

STEM is the future for food. It's never been more important to be knowledgeable on what makes food technology tick, from sustainable agriculture to innovation to biosecurity.

Time for Tech explores how the more we know about food science and technology, the more we can solve problems in everyday life. Celebrating the **National Science Week 2021 School Theme: Food: Different by Design**, students will learn all about sustainable agriculture and laboratory-developed foods as well as its (sometimes unintended) consequences, and so be better informed about STEM, career pathways and how we can all do our bit to support the planet. And how are we going to do that? With comedy of course!

The show consists of interactive science sketch comedy segments that centre on different aspects of food technology. Students in grades 5-9 will **learn about sustainable agriculture, the link between food technology and innovation, how technology helps design creative food solutions, and biosecurity in a COVID impacted world.**

How does my school prepare for the Livestream?

After you schedule a time slot, you will receive an email to confirm your livestream.

Four weeks before your scheduled date we will provide you with a Teacher Preparation Video and a Teacher Guide with very simple instructions of how to prepare students and access the livestream performance.

How do we access the Livestream?

Two weeks before your scheduled date, an email will be sent with your private school login password to access your Livestream Event. On the day of your Livestream, simply go to **www.PerformLivestream.com** and enter your private school password which will take you directly to your Livestream performance.

The Livestream performance can be watched in individual classrooms, the school hall, library, multipurpose room, or even have students log in and view from home.

What equipment/technology do we need?

All you need is a connection to the internet and somewhere for the students to watch, such as:

- Individual classroom interactive whiteboards
- Projector connected to a computer
- A large TV connected to a computer
- Individual students on their own device

If classes are watching from the same location, we highly recommend using the fewest devices/screens possible to tune in – both for the best collective experience, and to minimise strain on your school's network.

You should check in with your schools IT manager to see what will work best and we can also provide a test link before the day.
